

Welcome to BALI ECO DELI

How much do you make with the recyclable wastes you collect ?

BALI **ECO** DELI has set up a small recycling program on the island. Every month, with the support of other businesses¹, we collect & send to Bali hundreds of big rice bags full of recyclables. Logistic costs us a bit of money (about 50\$ / month) to pay for the bags & to transport the recyclables to mainland. We have a deal with the recycling company we work with : Bali Recycling picks-up our bags in Sanur, they do their job, we do not pay for the pick up service.

We do this at a very small scale compared to what could be done on the island ... but hopefully, after months of meetings we finally have some other businesses on the island doing their part. This is just the beginning and we really hope to get more & more businesses involved in order to make a cleaner island.

Is Bali Eco Deli a chain of coffee shops ?

Nop, we are an independent company with a single shop in Jungut Batu, Nusa Lembongan. We would be happy to open other shops in Bali or anywhere else but only with the right people : focusing on preserving local environment first !

Any plan in the future ?

We will move to a much bigger location, 300 meters from here, next summer. Building will start in the coming weeks using only sustainable material. The facility will include many eco-friendly features such as rain water harvesting system, grey water recycling unit, LED lights ... and the first and only full organic garden in Nusa Lembongan. We really look forward to welcome you there next year !
